1. How much do the educational builds cost? What is included with them? Is it similar to the Ultimate Self Build Zero or PLUS Kit?

This very much depends on the specification and the level of build, we are able to supply every part needed for either a donor base build or a new component build.

2. How detailed is the build manual? Photos of each stage or process?

We can get you a copy of this sent over to you, we offer full technical support through out and can arrange visit to support the build if needed.

3. Can we arrange a tour of your factory with our Engineering students? What group sizes can you accommodate?

Yes everything within the kit is design around the IVA requirements, we are then able to put the car through the IVA test and do all the registration paperwork etc.

7. How many hours have colleges or similar taken to build their cars? Very much depends on the college and how they are doing it, and how many students are working on the build etc.
